

Town Manager's Report

Main Street Committee

This committee continues to meet monthly with the goal of implementing the Main Street Master Plan and carrying out other work that will contribute to the improvement of Springfield.

The committee is planning to have another public meeting at the Hartness House the tentative date is December 7th. There will be an update on Main Street Master Plan and a presentation about TIF by White and Burke.

Paving Update

Paving and Chip Sealing is complete, excepting in the construction zone on Olive Street and the Vermont Roadworks work planned for part of Seavers Brook Road and Will Dean Road. That work was originally scheduled for September 18th and Vermont Roadworks has not provided a new completion date. The Town Highway Department has paved Park Street Bridge.

County Road Culvert Update

All concrete has been poured in the culvert's interior and the brook is now flowing through the culvert. Work to pour concrete on the exterior inlet end has begun and the contractor is ahead of schedule.

Tonnerville Trail Extension

There is a dispute between the Agency of Natural Resources and the Natural Resources Board regarding jurisdiction over the bike path and the demolition of J & L. SRDC has retained Downs Rachlin and Martin to assist with a resolution to the dispute.
