## **Springfield Receives Town of the Year Award from Windsor County Partners**

Windsor County Partners (WCP) provides youth mentoring services throughout Windsor County. Annually Springfield has provided a \$3,000 voted appropriation to WCP. At the WCP annual meeting on September 27th Springfield was honored and recognized as the WCP Town of the Year.

## **Paving Update**

All the subcontracted paving has been completed. There are still a few patch paving jobs that Public Works still plans to do before the end of the paving season.

## **Main Street Curb Extension**

It's getting late in the construction season but if the weather co-operates this project will still be done this year.

## **South Street Sidewalk**

VTrans did not approve the final construction design for this sidewalk. After 2 ½ years of going through the various approval processes, VTrans is now requesting the redesign of a major access along the sidewalk and they are also saying the original environmental approval has expired and that process must start again. We have requested an on-site meeting to resolve these issues. If things are not resolved to our (myself, the project manager and the design engineer) satisfaction we will begin to climb the VTrans management ladder until we get a reasonable solution.

## **Zoning Regulations Amendments**

The Planning Commission Public Hearing on the zoning regulations amendments is scheduled for November 7th. Following that hearing, the Selectboard needs to have two (2) public hearings on the zoning amendments.
