


CHARTER AMENDMENT REVISION

As a result of Public Hearings held on August 24, 2020 and September 14, 2020, the Springfield Selectboard has revised the proposed Charter Amendments dated July 20, 2020 as follows:

REVISION is under ARTICLE THREE, Section I, IV, C, 4. Paragraph 4 is entitled *Town Charter and collective bargaining agreements* and is amended with the addition of the word "have" after the words "which shall" as a result of September 14, 2020 Public Hearing:


The Selectboard shall have the sole authority to enter into collective bargaining agreements and may commit the town to collective bargaining agreements which shall have control over conflicting rules and regulations promulgated pursuant to this charter. The board of selectmen may not commit the town to any collective bargaining agreement which shall contradict, violate, or circumvent any provision of this Charter or ordinances passed pursuant to this Charter.


